To the Recipient of this Letter,

This Scout is striving to improve himself by achieving his next rank in the Advancement Program of the Boy Scouts of America. The Advancement Program is a method of stimulating boys in a desirable activity, of measuring results, and of providing recognition for those who have met the established high standards.

This Scout will appear before an Eagle Board of Review which will determine if he is qualified. A letter giving your frank and confidential opinion as to the Scout's qualifications will aid these men in making their decision and, if indicated, will guide this boy into areas of further improvement.

Your letter will be helpful if you comment on such qualifications as these:

1. Is he active in the meetings and projects of organizations to which he belongs?
2. Does he accept and carry out responsibilities?
3. Is he a leader?
4. Does he help in his home, school, his church or synagogue and community?
5. How does he care for the things that belong to him?
6. Does he respect the property of others?
7. Is he learning skills that develop self-reliance?
8. Does he understand and take part in the conservation of our natural resources?
9. How does he use the knowledge and skills acquired in merit badge work and other Scouting work?
10. Does he exemplify what you believe to be a good Scout Citizen?

It is quite possible that you will not have information on all of these items, but the knowledge which you do have concerning this Scout will help the Eagle Board of Review in their interview with him.

When you have complete your letter of recommendation, please sign it and place it in the envelope provided. Mail it to the addressee, who will present it to the Eagle Board of Review where it will be held in strict confidence, and used only in the best interests of this boy.
