

Troop 150 – Suggested Camping Gear List

- Scout uniform – required for travel and also for some activities
- Sleeping bag – packed in stuff sack
- Sleeping pad
- Pocket knife – must have Totin’Chip
- Extra change clothing – remember to dress in layers for the weather and to include extra socks, etc.
- Suitable footwear
- Hat, gloves etc. depending on weather
- Water bottle
- Rain gear
- Flashlight & spare batteries
- Mess kit – plate, bowl, cup, knife, fork, and spoon
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Personal hygiene gear – soap, washcloth, towel, etc.
- Watch
- Pen and paper
- Scout handbook
- Merit badge book if applicable

Note: Packing gear in a duffle bag works well for most Scouts and is easiest to pack into the vehicles. (Backpacks are not normally necessary and are more difficult to transport in the vehicles.) Remember to put your name on all of your gear and to pack clothing and equipment securely.
